Entries for all competitors except Wild Cards close on **THURSDAY 19th AUGUST 2010.**

All Wild Card Entries close on **MONDAY 23rd AUGUST 2010.**

NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED

ENTRIES: Will only be accepted on the National Championships Entry Form and should be sent to the Show Secretary. An A5 stamped addressed envelope with a **LARGE FIRST CLASS STAMP** must accompany each entry so that passes and tickets may be sent enabling access to the showground.

PAYMENT: All Cheques payable to "THE NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS".

WITHDRAWALS: 03/09/10 (late withdrawals to 07771 758830)

TIMES: 04/09/10 between 6.00pm – 10.00pm by telephoning 01993 832 673 or 07771 758 830. Times will also be available www.bdchampionships.co.uk from 10.00am 04/09/10. Please note that as this is a Championship ALL dressage times are drawn and cannot be changed.

DECLARATIONS: Competitors must declare at the Secretary's Office.

BRIDLE NUMBER: Must be worn in accordance to Rule 71.

REFUNDS OF ENTRIES AND STABLING: A refund of 50% of the entry and / or stable fees will be made to competitors withdrawing prior to the Close of Entries on 19th August 2010, after which, any stable fee and the entry fee is non-refundable.

REPRESENTED CHEQUES: Any payment that is returned by the bank for whatever reason will be subject to an additional £15.00 administration fee. This fee will be charged each time the bank returns any payment.

MUSIC: All music should be on mini-disc or CD to avoid problems during performance. The Organisers will not be responsible for any mishap during competition, for damaged or poor quality recordings. The mini-discs or CDs must be handed into the Secretary's Office by 10.00am on Saturday 11th September for the Inter 1 Freestyle or 10.00am on Sunday 12th September for the GP Freestyle, with full instructions. Back up copies should be supplied.

TIMETABLE TIMES: Dressage Arenas and all timetable times are an approximate guide and therefore subject to final amendment.

WARM UP ARENAS: The horse walk and exercise arenas will open at 4.00pm and close at 7.00pm on Wednesday 8th September. Access to the horse walk and waxed all weather warm up arenas will close 10 minutes after the final prize giving in the main arena each day. The horse walk will open each morning 5 minutes prior to Morning Walk Exercise. The grass exercise area is open throughout the hours of daylight.

PRACTICE JUDGING: No.

LOCATION: Entrance to the Royal Showground is through GATE 3 ONLY. Exit from the A46 (Warwick to Coventry dual carriageway) at the Leamington Spa, Kenilworth exit. At the roundabout at the top of the slip road take the A452 towards Leamington Spa. Turn 1st left onto B4115. Gate 3 Entrance to the Showground will be approx. 2 miles on your right.

SHOWGROUND ACCESS: Horses may arrive on the showground from 12noon on Wednesday 8th September and the Horsebox Entrance will close at 11.00pm. The Horsebox Entrance to the showground will be open from 6.00am – 11.00pm on show days. Horses requiring stabling should arrive on the showground before 7.00pm. Should any competitor be delayed, they must contact the **Stable Manager** on 07779 788014

STABLING: Temporary plastic stabling (3m x 3m) will be available on the showground. Stables must be booked on the **National Championship Stabling Form** and paid for in advance with your entry to **The Secretary**. Prices and conditions are on the official stable form. **Stable hire is from 3.00pm – 3.00pm.** Stables must be vacated on time so that incoming horses may be stabled. Your co-operation in leaving stables promptly and clean will be appreciated. Lighting is not provided within the stables. Any damage caused to stables will be charged to the hirer. No straw is permitted. Additional bedding may be purchased on-site from the Stable Manager.

COMPETITOR CARAVANS: There is no charge to competitors competing at the Championships who, rather than use live-in horseboxes wish to bring a caravan or camp on the showground. Competitors should indicate their intention to bring a caravan or tent on the Official Stable Form and should contact the Stable Manager upon arrival. Electric is not available for tents. Caravans or tents may not be located next to the competitor's horsebox or horse trailer.

HORSEBOX ELECTRICAL HOOK UP: Competitors competing at the Championships may book electrical hook up for their horsebox in advance by contacting Stoneleigh Park Lodge Hotel on 02476 690 123.

JUST DRESSAGE RIDERS MARQUEE: Sited in the stable area. Snacks from 12noon on Wednesday. Breakfast from 7.00am – 11.00am on Wednesday / Thursday / Friday / Sunday. Evening meals from 5.00pm – 9.30pm on Wednesday & 6.00pm – 9.30pm on Thursday / Friday. Licensed bar from 12noon – 11.00pm on Wednesday & 5.30pm – 11pm on Thursday / Friday.

SMOKING: Is not permitted within any of the buildings on the showground or within the stable area.

DOGS: Are permitted on the showground, but must be kept under control at all times. If in the opinion of the Show Organiser, any person fails to control their dog/s they will be asked to leave the showground.

VEHICLES: The Show Organiser reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access even if locked and unattended and the Show Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal. The Show Organiser or any agent of the show will not be liable for any loss or damage to any vehicle that has to be towed for whatever reason.

RADIO HEADSETS: Commentary can be received on radio headsets, which will be available to purchase from the Secretary's Office or the BD Trade Stand.

Application for Members Admission Tickets must be supported by a Membership Number (BD, Riding Club or Pony Club) when applying for tickets and are only available for a maximum of 4 tickets (Adult / Child / 4 Day Adult / 4 Day Child or mix of 4 of these tickets) per single Membership Number.

Admission Tickets on the Gate during the Show- Adults Thursday / Friday £12.00, Saturday / Sunday £16.00 Children £8.00. Child tickets are for children 16 years or under. Children 6 years and under go free and do not require an admission ticket.

SPECIAL AWARDS:

Eligibility MUST be stated on the Entry Form to qualify for the following awards:

BD AMATEUR OWNER/RIDER AWARD (AOR): To the highest placed Amateur Owner/Rider open to those riding a horse registered in their name, or that of an immediate family member, and who compete in horse sports for recreational purposes only. Integrity caveat: This award is intended to recognise genuine amateur owner/riders. Only declare for this award if you genuinely feel that you are eligible according to the spirit in which this is intended. Eligibility must be stated at the point of entry to qualify for this award. The winner of these awards will be expected to come in for prize giving even if not in top 10. Class 11 is not included in this award

BEST BRITISH BRED AWARD (BB): A rosette will be awarded by The Lead Body for British Performance Sport Horses & Ponies (PSPH) to the highest placed British Bred horse in all championships except classes 8 & 11. This award is not presented below 10th Place in a class.

TYRELL TROPHY: Kindly donated by Lady Caroline Tyrell for the highest placed British Mare. (Presented at the National Convention).

The Following Awards will be awarded automatically and do not require declaration on the Entry Form:

BD OWNERS AWARD: British Dressage are providing an award to the Owner of the winning horse in all Championships. The award is to the Supreme Champion in the Shearwater Potential International Dressage Horse Championship and to each Grade winner in the KBIS Para Equestrian Dressage Championship. The awards may be collected from the Show Secretary's Office after each prize giving.

DRESSAGE DELUXE GROOMS AWARD: A gift will be given by Dressage Deluxe to the groom of the winning horse in each Championship. This may be collected from the Stable Manager's Office after each prize giving.

SADDLERS COMPANY: A £35 Saddlery Voucher very kindly donated by the Worshipful Company of Saddlers will be awarded to the winner of the Preliminary and Novice Restricted. A £40 Saddlery Voucher very kindly donated by the Worshipful Company of Saddlers will be awarded to the rider with the highest overall percentage across all five grades of the Para Equestrian Championships.

STEELE SALVER: Awarded to the horse gaining the most Steel Salver points throughout the season. (Presented at the National Convention).
